2 Taxes Abolished By Virginia Village

The town of Clifton in southwestern Fairfax County has abolished personal property and real estate taxes.

Mayor W. Swem Elgin said yesterday the town council relieved Clifton's 300 citizens from paying the taxes because the revenue from them was no longer necessary to finance town services.

A rise in the automobile tag fee from \$5 to \$10 made the action possible, Elgin said. Clifton also receives a share of State Alcoholic Beverage profits.
