Clifton Asks Fairfax To Ban All Hunting

Fairfax County has been asked to wrap its wildlife in a coat of legal armor, turning the hunter into the hunted.

The little town of Clifton in western Fairfax is seeking to make the County's partial hunting ban complete. Specifically, its residents are tired of buckshot passing by the kitchen door and into their pet squirrels.

Hunting is illegal in Clifton but permissible in the rural area surrounding it. The Town Council voted Dec. 3 to ask the Board of County Supervisors to ban hunting and "uncontrolled discharge of firearms" everywhere in the County.
